

EODH DYNAMICALLY PRESENT AT EUROSATORY 2026

EODH S.A., the Greek defense industry company, is participating for the 10th consecutive time in the EUROSATORY 2026 International Defence and Security Exhibition in Paris (Hall 6, G-380), presenting innovative and proven protection technologies as well as, for the first time, integrated upgrade systems for land platforms.



Within its 120 m² exhibition space, EODH is displaying a LEOPARD 1A5 main battle tank turret mock-up integrating the advanced **'ASPIS Modular New Generation (NG)-MBT'** protection system (ASPIS – Advanced Shielding Platform Integrated System). The solution proposed by EODH through “ASPIS” can be applied as an **upgrade to existing main battle tanks and armored vehicles or integrated into new designs**, addressing the **survivability challenges** posed by modern battlefield threats such as **drones**, loitering munitions and top-attack anti-tank missiles, tandem-warhead anti-tank guided missiles (**ATGM**), and the new generation of long-rod **APFSDS** penetrator rounds. “ASPIS” has been designed as an integrated solution that **combines passive and active protection elements to effectively counter multiple hits**, while after each impact the armor modules can be **replaced in the field by the crew**. Specifically for countering top-attack threats, the ASPIS system uses an appropriate number of autonomous millimeter-wave radar sensors distributed on the roof of the turret/vehicle, which, when activated, **detect incoming threats** approaching the roof from high elevation angles and, at the appropriate moment, initiate directed explosive charges to neutralize the threat.



In addition, in cooperation with the Belgian - Spanish company DUMA, an Industrial Partner of the Company, EODH is presenting the **4x4 ASV350 MRAV** equipped with an **ASPIS (light)** mock-up. **This exhibit demonstrates the adaptability of the modular protection system for integration into light and medium platforms**, offering significantly enhanced survivability without compromising operational performance.

Furthermore, the **SPECTRE UGV** unmanned ground vehicle of DUMA is also on display, fitted with a **LOKI 7.62 RWS** turret by Slovenia's VALHALLA, also an Industrial Partner of EODH, presenting a modern operational approach to the use of unmanned ground vehicles. Recognizing that this trend will be particularly important in the future, EODH has developed a specially designed proposal for an integrated approach within maneuver units as well as for individual land platforms.

The collaboration with Slovenian VALHALLA, a specialist in turrets and a trusted partner of EODH, is showcased at the booth through the display of a **MANGART 25** turret mock-up, presented as a proposal for an Armored Fighting Vehicle Upgrade Package and for the substantial enhancement of their operational capabilities.

Finally, stands are exhibiting numerous ballistic test modules featuring **cutting-edge technologies**, covering levels of NEW high, medium-low protection and **Spall Liners**, providing, for the first time, an indicative picture of **the scope of EODH's Research & Development (R&D) testing** as well as its industrial products and **unique expertise in advanced protection systems**. Combining know-how with a deep understanding of evolving threat environments, EODH develops protection solutions designed to meet the challenges of the modern battlefield. **The company's focus on innovation ensures adaptable and effective protection capabilities** for current and future armored vehicle platforms. Notably, EODH products have already been

integrated into platforms such as the **LEO2A8 MBT**, the **PUMA IFV** and the **BOXER 8X8** armored vehicle family, further highlighting the company's expertise and reliability. **EODH is a Key Industrial Partner of KNDS Germany and other recognized manufacturers.**



As recognition of all the above efforts, EODH was named by the Financial Times in 2022 as one of the fastest-growing companies in Europe. The company was also recognized as one of the “Diamonds of the Greek Economy” for three consecutive years (2023, 2024 and 2025), while in 2026 it was awarded the **ECO Vadis Gold Star accreditation**, ranking it among the **top 5% of European companies in the fields of rapid industrial growth and sustainability, with a distinguished social and environmental footprint.**

This dynamic business environment ultimately led to the creation of **EODH Dynamics**, a wholly owned subsidiary of EODH. **EODH Dynamics** has prepared well-considered and fully substantiated proposals for the upgrade of existing land platforms, tailored to the operational needs of each user. **These upgrades/modernizations** are not limited solely to achieving the highest possible level of protection and survivability for the crew and vehicle, **but extend to the holistic upgrade of each platform**, integrating modern operational capabilities. **The company is building a new industrial facility covering 10,000 sq.m., equipped with state-of-the-art systems and specialized machinery for the construction, assembly, upgrade and provision of comprehensive technical support for land combat platforms.** The new plant will soon expand EODH's existing capabilities in Greece, Cyprus and abroad, creating approximately 200 new jobs, in the first phase, for the local community. **The new factory is scheduled to begin operations in 2027.**
